1. Posters should be on plain, unlined white paper, 8 ½ x 11. Portrait or Landscape is fine.
2. Artists may use crayons, poster paints, watercolor, markers, ink, fabric, tissue paper or other materials as long as they do not smear or crack. Computer-generated drawings will be disqualified.
3. Submissions must be your independent work – joint or group submissions will not be judged.
4. Submissions must be original artwork; no trademark or copyrighted material.
5. Posters may be reproduced on ESLC marketing materials or put on display at ESLC events and will be considered property of ESLC.
6. Label your poster on the back by taping an index card to the back of your entry with the following information. **ENTRIES THAT DO NOT HAVE THIS INFORMATION WILL NOT BE JUDGED.**
